Re: *EPA v. EME Homer City Generation, L. P.*, 572 U. S. ____ (2014)
(decided April 29, 2014)

Please make the following changes to your print and electronic versions of the above-captioned case: In the dissenting opinion, page 7, lines 9–10, change the phrase “where an upwind State contributes pollutants to only a *single* downwind State” to “where only a *single* upwind State contributes pollutants to a downwind State”.

On page 12, change the title of Part I–D from: “D. Plus Ça Change: EPA’s Continuing Quest for Cost-Benefit Authority” to “D. Our Precedent”. In Part I–D, lines 10–11, change “is not for EPA or this Court to determine” to “is for Congress, not this Court, to determine.” In line 12, change “EPA has” to “parties have”. And in line 15, change “EPA’s contention that it could consider” to “the contention that EPA should consider”.
